8* MOTION- PAYMENT OF PENSIONS TO EMPLOYEES

Mr. Speaker Sir, I beg to move the following motion;

THAT, Aware that Consumer protection, including standards for social security and professional pension plans is a function of the National Government as stipulated in Part 1 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010; **Further aware that** Section 6(2) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 stipulates that the Governments at the National and County levels are distinct and inter-dependent and shall conduct their mutual relations on the basis of consultation and cooperation; **Noting that** An officer who has rendered pensionable service to the Government of Kenya expects the payment of retirement benefits in accordance with the provisions of the Pensions Act, CAP 189; **Further Noting that** in accordance with the provisions of the Pensions Act (Cap.189) Civil Servants or their dependants may be paid, on leaving the service of the Government and on fulfilling certain conditions; **Concerned that** then the Defunct local authorities didn't remit all or part of the Pension deductions to the pension schemes available then;

Further concerned that there exists a number of retired employees who worked for the then Nanyuki and Nyahururu Municipalities, Laikipia County Council and other defunct local authorities within Laikipia and Laikipia County Government who have not yet received their benefits as an incentive for the services they rendered to the country for a number of years of their working life; this House **urges** the County Government in liaison with the relevant National Government Agencies to:

1. Budget for the payments of pensions and other allied benefits.
2. Fast track settlement of the delayed benefits as this would come as a huge relief for the senior citizens who often do not have any other source of income after leaving employment.
