8* MOTION- BURSARY FUNDS DISBURSEMENT

Mr. Speaker Sir, I beg to move the following motion;

THAT, Aware that Article 43(1)f of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 stipulates that every person has the right to education; **Further aware** that the Laikipia County Bursary Fund Act, 2014 established Laikipia County Education Bursary Fund whose main purpose is to provide financial assistance to the poor and vulnerable students in the County in order to increase access to education; promote and increase enrolment, retention, completion and transition rates in schools; improve education standards and literacy levels; reduce poverty, disparities and inequality; **Noting that** the County Government function in accordance to Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule is Pre-primary education, village polytechnics, homecraft centres and childcare facilities; **Further noting that** the County Government is spending funds on pre-primary education which if children from poor families without income aren't supported through the transition from primary school to secondary and subsequent to tertiary education, the country won't be able to achieve Kenya vision 2030; **Concerned that** in order to realize the national development goals, relevant and quality education and

training is required to meet the human development needs of a rapidly changing and a more diverse economy;

3. To issue Kshs. 5,000 per student in Boarding Secondary Schools and;
4. To issue Kshs. 2,500 per student in Day Secondary Schools;
