a. Notice of Motion- MOTION URGING THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO ESTABLISH A POLICY FOR MAXIMUM UTILISATION OF NATURAL RESOURCES

Noting that implementation of specific National Government policies on natural resources and environmental conservation is a function of the County Government as stipulated in Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya 2010; **Further noting that** natural resources provide fundamental life support in the form of both consumptive goods and public services; **Aware that** human progress and development requires a rational use of natural resources, which will seek to avoid waste and benefits local community, which can occur both in production and in consumption; **Concerned that** Laikipia County is endowed with natural resources which include sand, wildlife and water which at some point act as a source of conflict; this House **urges** the County Government to establish a policy that will seek to:

1. Maximize the utilization of natural resources in order to benefit community/public.
2. Avoid over-exploitation and promote sustainability of environment by building dykes.
3. In partnership with national Government carry out mineral survey and exploitation.
4. Establish conservancies to promote tourism and conservation in the County.
5. Address human-wildlife conflict.
