1. NOTICES OF MOTIONS

a. Notice of motion- MOTION URGING THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO LIAISE WITH THE NATIONAL MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE TO UPSCALE CROP AND LIVESTOCK INSURANCE WITH THE GOAL OF CUSHIONING FARMERS AGAINST CLIMATE RELATED RISKS.

Aware that Agriculture including crop and animal husbandry is a function of the County Government as stipulated in part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010; **Further aware that** Food security is a vital component in the economic growth of any country; **Noting that** food security is one of H.E The President's big four agenda; **Further noting that** Most crop and livestock production in Kenya is rain fed, and as such is highly exposed to the weather-related perils of drought and flooding, as well as to pests and disease; **Observing that** the National Government had initiated crop and livestock insurance program; this House **urges** the County Government to liaise with the national ministry of Agriculture and upscale crop and livestock insurance with the goal of cushioning farmers against climate related risks.

b. Notice of motion- MOTION URGING THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO SCALE UP THE PROVISION OF SPECIALISED EQUIPMENT AND TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF HEALTH FACILITIES AT THE COMMUNITY LEVEL INCLUDING MOBILE HEALTH SERVICES IN ORDER TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF KENYANS WHO ACCESS HEALTHCARE.

Aware that Article 43(1) a of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 stipulates that every person has the right to the highest attainable standard of health, which includes the right to health care services, including reproductive health care; **Further aware** of H.E The President's Big Four Agenda on providing Universal Health Coverage to guarantee quality and affordable Healthcare to all Kenyans; **Noting that** some residents of this County in vast areas travel for longer distances in search of medical services; this House **urges** the County Government to scale up the provision of specialized medical equipment and increase the

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number of health facilities at the community level including mobile health services in order to increase the number of Kenyans who access specialized healthcare which is in accordance to H.E The President's Big Four Agenda.
