c. Notice of Motion- MOTION URGING THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO DEVELOP A POLICY THAT WILL GUIDE, SET STANDARDS AND IMPROVE THE PROCESS OF MEDICAL EQUIPMENT DONATIONS

**THAT, noting that** county health services including in particular county health facilities and pharmacies is a function of the County Government as stipulated in Part 2 of the fourth schedule of the Constitution; **Further noting that** according to the guidelines for healthcare equipment donations by the World Health Organisation, many developing countries are increasingly dependent on donor assistance to meet the equipment needs of their healthcare systems; **Appreciating** the work of donor aid that includes donation of medical equipment to our county health facilities; **Aware that** most of such donated equipment are lying idle in our health facilities since they are incompatible with the existing technology; This house **urges** the County Government to develop a policy that will guide, set standards and improve the process of medical equipment donations to the mutual benefit of both donors and the county.

**Noting that** County transport, including county roads is a function of County Government as stipulated in Part 2 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010; **Aware that** Road infrastructure opens up unconnected regions to trade & investment and improves access to goods and services; **Appreciating that** the County Government has undertaken gravelling, murraming, construction and repair of roads and bridges in each financial year thus easing connectivity within the wards and the county at large; **Concerned that** heavy rainfall in the past few months has led to inaccessible roads; this House **urges** the County Government to prioritize repairing the dilapidated roads first before undertaking the rest of the road works in the current financial year.
