- a. Notice of Motion- **REPORT ON PUBLIC PARTICIPATION OF THE  
LAIKIPIA COUNTY TRADE BILL, 2018**

**THAT**, this house adopts the Trade, Tourism and Cooperative Development Committee public participation report on the Laikipia County Trade Bill, 2018 dated 17th March, 2019.

- b. Notice of Motion- **MOTION URGING THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT  
TO DESIGNATE SMOKING AREAS WITHIN THE COUNTY**

**Noting that**, Article 43(1a) of the Constitution of Kenya 2010, stipulates that every person has the right to the highest attainable standard of health, which includes the right to health care services, including reproductive health care; **Further noting that** Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 stipulates that County health services, including, in particular promotion of primary health care is a function of County Government; **Aware that** Tobacco control Act, 2007 seeks to protect the general public from the harmful effects of exposure to tobacco smoke; **Further aware that** section 33 of the Tobacco Control Act, 2007 bans smoking in public places and further Section 35 of the same Act, requires that the manager or owner of a prohibited smoking area may provide specially designated smoking areas within such place; **Concerned that** tobacco use is among the five leading behavioural causes of cancer, and is responsible for about a third of cancer deaths globally, according to World Health Organization;

**Alarmed that** non-smokers also suffer from the risk of lung cancer due to second hand smoking; this House **urges** the County Government to construct and ensure that all public places have designated smoking areas that meet the requirements of section 35(2) of Tobacco Control Act, 2007.

c. Notice of Motion- **MOTION URGING THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO PARTNER WITH ORGANISATIONS IN ORDER TO RECYCLE WASTE PRODUCTS**

**THAT Noting that,** County health services, including, in particular refuse removal, refuse dumps and solid waste disposal is a function of the County Government under part 2 of the Fourth schedule of the Constitution of Kenya 2010; **Further noting that** urbanization is associated with increased generation of solid waste; **Concerned that** Poor solid waste management has negative health impacts, including the spread of infectious and non-communicable diseases, environmental degradation and greenhouse gas emissions; this House **urges** the County Government to create awareness to its residents about waste reduction and recycling and partner with other organizations in order to reuse and recycle waste products.
