Mr. Speaker Sir, I beg to move the following motion;

Noting that agriculture including livestock sale yards is a function of the County Government as stipulated in the fourth schedule of the Constitution of Kenya 2010;
Further noting that livestock sale yards faces a myriad of challenges including mismanagement of livestock sale, lack of basic amenities and lack of market stalls; aware that good infrastructure of livestock sale yards directly facilitates efficient market and trade performance, and, by extension, affects producer prices; this House urges the county government to:

1. Carry out an inventory of all the sale yards and their status and table a report within 20 calendar days to this House.
2. Establish adequate holding pens and up to standard livestock sale yards enclosed with a perimeter fence of appropriate durable material with suitable entry and exit points for both livestock and market actors.
3. Provide basic amenities in the said sale yards i.e. public toilets and water.

APPENDIX**1. NOTICES OF MOTIONS****a. Notice of motion- (Hon. Peter Matunge, Nominated MCA)**

Noting that agriculture including livestock sale yards is a function of the County government as stipulated in the fourth schedule of the Constitution of Kenya 2010; **further noting** that livestock sale yards in our County is mismanaged leading to dirty livestock sale yards and non-involvement of the community in decision-making; aware that these livestock sale yards lack market stalls; this house **urges** the County Government to establish a livestock sale yard policy that seeks to:

3. Construct decent market stalls at the livestock sale yards.
