8*MOTION- MOTION URGING THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO ADDRESS THE INFLUX OF LIVESTOCK FROM NEIGHBOURING COUNTIES

Mr. Speaker Sir, I beg to move the following motion:-

That, noting that pursuant to Article 29 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010, every person has the right to freedom and security; **Further noting that** Article 6 (2) stipulates that the Governments at the national and county levels are distinct and inter-dependent and shall conduct their mutual relations on the basis of consultation and cooperation; **Aware** of the influx of livestock from Samburu and Isiolo Counties to seek pasture in Laikipia County; **Further aware that** this may cause conflict among the pastoralists, farmers and the ranch owners in Laikipia County; **Concerned that** this may threaten the security in the County; this House **urges** the County Government to avail resources and initiate consultation between Isiolo County Government, Samburu County Government, National Government agencies responsible for security and Livestock, other relevant stakeholders and Laikipia County Government both the executive and

the legislature arms in order to address the said influx of livestock from the neighbouring counties, before it gets out of hand, with the aim of promoting peaceful coexistence of the communities in the three Counties.
